Accelerated Reader Home Connect

As you may know, students in grades 2-8 are using a computer software program called Accelerated Reader to practice reading skills at school. This program has a special feature called Home Connect that lets you see how your student is doing from almost any computer with internet access. Home Connect gives you access to your students overall progress on Reading Practice Quizzes and Vocabulary Practice Quizzes. Home Connect also has a link to AR Book Finder which will help you find books with Accelerated Reader Quizzes for your child based on subject,
