PRINCIPAL/SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

A. Mr. Blessman informed the School Board that the original amount that the Department of Labor said that Riverview was going to owe was approximately \$1000.00. After receiving the final letter from them, Dianne noticed discrepancies and contacted the Department of Labor and got the total amount reduced to approximately \$740.00.

B. Joe Blessman advised that over the winter break, AAA Northgate was in the building to fix the five remaining furnaces. Mike Kirk from AAA told the Superintendent Blessman that his company could fix those furnaces under the \$10,000 limit. The bill to complete the furnaces was \$6700. Joe Blessman also discussed purchase programmable thermostats for the furnaces. This would eliminate the computer in the office.

C. Joe Blessman asked for guidance in regard to holiday pay for hourly employees. Lucy Zeller asked Joe to find out what the law reads on holiday pay.

D. Joe Blessman informed the School Board that there is a lawsuit filed against Workers Compensation. Mr. Blessman stated that there is nothing that the School will have to do; he just wanted to make sure that the School Board is kept up to date on our workers compensation claims.
